What do we do in Scouts?

We camp, we ski, we climb rocks, we hike, we march in parades, we learn knots, we learn how to safely handle knives and axes and how to build a campfire. We even attend a professional baseball game where we run the flag ceremony to start the game. Every year we help our sponsor run their Family Fun Day. We also help out at the Jewish Federation's Super Sunday fund raiser. We also work with other Scout units to collect food for the local kosher food pantry.

How is Scouting different than other youth activities?

Scouting is aimed at developing the individual boy. Team sports have stars that get most of the playing time. In Scouting we help EVERY boy become a star. While we have fun, we impart important life lessons. We also **never** schedule a Scout activity that would conflict with the Sabbath or any Jewish holiday.

Summer Camp

Each summer, boys get to spend one or two weeks at camp swimming, advancing, boating, climbing, enjoying campfires and making new friends. Cub Scouts entering 5th grade in the fall can also spend a week at summer camp.
